***HOLLISTON***

In order to serve on the School Committee, an individual must be a registered voter in the town of Holliston and he/she must take an oath of office as required by law.

Each new member will swear the oath before an officer duly qualified to administer oaths prior to entering on his/her official duties as a member of the Committee. From the town clerk, newly qualified Committee members, by law, receive and sign a receipt for a copy of the Massachusetts Open Meeting Law governing the conduct of Committee meetings in general and executive sessions in particular.

Membership on a School Committee is not limited by race, color, sex, religion, national origin, or sexual orientation.

This policy is established by law.
